Departing from Folkestone, this journey winds through the **Ardennes, Black Forest, Alps, and Dolomites** before diving deep into the wild beauty of the **Balkans**.

Ride legendary mountain passes in northern Italy, cruise beside crystal-clear alpine lakes in **Slovenia**, and explore the rugged landscapes of **Bosnia, Montenegro, Albania, and North Macedonia** — with highlights including Mostar, Kotor, and Lake Ohrid.

Cross back into Italy for the **Apennines and Tuscany**, with stops in Pienza and Lucca, before climbing beneath Mont Blanc and sweeping through France's wine and **Champagne regions** on the ride home.

From alpine peaks and dramatic coastlines to medieval towns and vineyard roads, **this is more than a tour — it's a true continental odyssey.**

After a smooth tunnel crossing, we roll onto the open roads of northern France. The pace is relaxed as we cruise through sleepy villages, sunflower fields, and peaceful farmland — the perfect way to ease into continental riding.

Near the Belgian border, the scenery shifts to winding lanes, rolling hills, and the deep green forests of the Ardennes. The roads begin to twist, sharpening the senses and setting the tone for the journey.

By afternoon, we're deep in the woods, arriving at a quiet, family-run lodge hidden among the trees. With a log fire, a cold beer, and the hush of the forest, it's the perfect place to properly kick off the adventure.

## DAY 2

Today's ride sweeps through three countries in one unforgettable day. We wind out of the Ardennes through misty lanes and quiet villages before slipping into Luxembourg, where smooth, flowing roads carve through valleys and storybook scenery.

From there, we head into Germany and the heart of the Black Forest, riding rollercoaster roads beneath towering pines and past timber-framed houses and roadside cafés. Every mile invites you to lean in and enjoy the rhythm.

By evening, we arrive at our forest lodge with warm bikes, cold beer, and hearty local food waiting. Woodsmoke drifts through the air — the perfect end to a proper day's riding.

# BLACK FOREST TO GARMISCH-PARTENKIRCHEN

## DAY 3

**Start Location:** Black Forest

**End Location:** Garmisch-Partenkirchen

**Distance:** Approx. **190 Miles**

### Highlights:

- Scenic ride along the edge of the Alps
- Rolling Bavarian countryside & winding valley roads
- Historic towns & timber-framed villages
- Beer halls, mountains & alpine charm



We leave the Black Forest and head southeast, trading dark pine corridors for open valleys and rolling landscapes as the Alps begin to rise ahead. It's a day for smooth throttle, sweeping roads, and easy rhythm through rivers, meadows, and wide-open scenery.

The Bavarian countryside delivers storybook villages, domed churches, and welcoming roadside inns, with mountain peaks growing larger on the horizon. A lakeside snack or village coffee stop adds to the relaxed pace.

By afternoon, we arrive in Garmisch-Partenkirchen, surrounded by towering peaks and alpine charm. With beer halls, hearty food, and views of the Zugspitze, it's the perfect place to unwind after another brilliant day on the road.

# GARMISCH-PARTENKIRCHEN TO BOLZANO (SOUTH TYROL)

## DAY 4

We leave Garmisch in crisp mountain air and head straight into alpine territory, climbing and twisting through high passes as Germany fades into Austria almost unnoticed. Every bend brings fresh views and a reason to slow down and take it in.

Jagged peaks, rushing streams, and echoing cowbells guide us into Italy and down into South Tyrol, where Austrian precision meets Italian flair. The roads are flawless, framed by scenery that feels straight out of a film.

By afternoon, we reach Bolzano, a crossroads of cultures with espresso bars, beer halls, and an easygoing buzz. With pizza, prosecco, and the first glimpse of the Dolomites, the high-altitude adventure truly begins.

**Highlights:**

Ride through Germany, Austria, and into Italy  
Scenic climbs and dramatic alpine views  
Cross alpine passes with sweeping switchbacks  
Arrive in Bolzano — gateway to the Dolomites



# DOLOMITE DAY LOOP RIDE (PASS BLITZ!)

## DAY 5

This is what we came for — the pure thrill of riding the Dolomites. With panniers off and spirits high, we tackle the legendary Sella Ronda, looping through towering limestone peaks and some of Europe's best mountain roads.

We climb over famous passes like Pordoi, Gardena, Sella, and Giau, riding a ribbon of hairpins, sweepers, and perfectly paved descents. Alpine huts, espresso stops, and jaw-dropping views appear at every turn.

It's a ride-your-own-pace kind of day — stop when you like, push on when you feel it. By evening, we're back in Bolzano, buzzing with adrenaline and already replaying every bend in our heads.

# BOLZANO TO BLED

## DAY 6

**Start Location:** Bolzano, Italy  
**End Location:** Bled, Slovenia  
**Distance:** Approx. **130 miles**

- Dolomite passes and alpine valleys
- Forests, rivers, and mountain sweepers
- Lake Bled — fairytale setting

Leaving Bolzano, we climb back into the Dolomites before heading east toward Slovenia. The roads twist through peaks and valleys, then ease into sweeping forest routes as we cross the border.

By afternoon, we arrive at Lake Bled — famous for its emerald waters, island church, and castle on the cliffs.

A picture-perfect spot to unwind after a day in the saddle.



# BLEM TO UNA NATIONAL PARK

## DAY 7

**Start Location:** Bled, Slovenia

**End Location:** Una National Park, Bosnia & Herzegovina

**Distance:** Approx. **200 miles**

- Cross from Slovenia into Bosnia
- Ride through rolling Balkan hills and rivers
- Overnight in unspoiled Una National Park

We leave Lake Bled behind and head south-east, following winding roads through Slovenia's mountains before crossing into Bosnia. The ride feels wilder and more remote, with rolling hills, quiet rivers, and small villages dotted along the route.

By late afternoon we reach Una National Park, a region of unspoiled forests, turquoise rivers, and waterfalls — the perfect place to slow the pace, relax, and soak up the atmosphere of the Balkans.



# UNA NATIONAL PARK TO MOSTAR

## DAY 8

**Start Location:** Una National Park, Bosnia & Herzegovina  
**End Location:** Mostar, Bosnia & Herzegovina  
**Distance:** Approx. **200 miles**

- Scenic ride through rural Bosnia
- Afternoon arrival in Mostar
- Explore the famous Ottoman bridge and old town

We roll south through Bosnia, trading national park roads for rural highways and sweeping country bends. The scenery shifts between wooded valleys and wide open stretches, with plenty of stops for coffee in roadside cafés.

By early afternoon, we descend into Mostar — a city of Ottoman bridges, mosques, and cobbled streets. With time to wander, we'll explore the famous Stari Most bridge and soak up the unique mix of East and West that makes this one of the Balkans' most memorable towns.



# MOSTAR TO KOTOR

## DAY 9

A shorter riding day gives us time for a leisurely start in Mostar before we head south. The road winds through valleys and along rivers before we cross into Montenegro, where the Adriatic coastline opens up before us.

By mid-afternoon we roll into Kotor, a stunning old town set on a bay that feels more like a fjord. Tonight we relax among Venetian walls, waterfront cafés, and breathtaking mountain views.

**End Location:** Kotor, Montenegro

**Distance:** Approx. **130 miles**

- Short, relaxed ride south through Bosnia
- Cross into Montenegro along the Adriatic
- Evening in the Bay of Kotor — a UNESCO gem



# KOTOR TO THETH

## DAY 10

**Start Location: Kotor, Montenegro**  
**End Location: Theth, Albania**  
**Distance: Approx. 100 miles**

- Theth, Albania
- Remote mountain roads into the Accursed Mountains
- Overnight in the wild valley of Theth

Leaving Kotor, we ride along Montenegro's rugged coast before cutting inland to cross into Albania. The ride is short but unforgettable — narrow, twisting mountain roads climb into the Accursed Mountains, one of Europe's last true frontiers.

We end the day in Theth, a remote valley village surrounded by dramatic peaks. It's a place where time feels frozen, with stone houses, waterfalls, and pristine wilderness right outside our hotel.



# THETH TO OHRID

## DAY 11

**Start Location: Theth, Albania**

**End Location: Ohrid, North Macedonia**

**Distance: Approx. 200 miles**

- Ride from the Albanian highlands to North Macedonia
- Cross mountain passes and border roads
- Evening by Lake Ohrid's historic old town

We say farewell to Theth's wild valley and ride east through Albania's highlands. The day is packed with twisting passes, rural backroads, and border crossings as we make our way into North Macedonia.

By evening we reach Lake Ohrid, one of Europe's oldest and deepest lakes. The old town is a lively mix of cobbled alleys, monasteries, and lakeside cafés — the perfect place to settle in for the night after a day of pure Balkan adventure.



# OHRID – REST DAY

## DAY 12

**Start Location:** Ohrid, North Macedonia

**End Location:** Ohrid, North Macedonia

**Distance:** Approx. **Rest Day**

- Relax lakeside or take a boat trip
- Wander the cobbled old town streets
- Explore historic monasteries and fortresses

Today is yours to enjoy at your own pace. Spend the morning wandering Ohrid's old town, a UNESCO site filled with Byzantine churches and Ottoman houses.

Take a boat across the lake to secluded monasteries, or simply relax with a drink on the waterfront. A perfect chance to slow down, recharge, and soak in the atmosphere.

**Distance: Approx. 150 miles**

# DAY 13

## OHRID TO BERAT

- Cross back into Albania
- Ride through rural valleys and quiet roads
- Overnight in Berat — the “City of a Thousand Windows”

We leave Ohrid and cross into Albania, following winding valley roads and mountain routes toward Berat. The ride is full of contrasts: farmland, hilltop villages, and twisting river gorges.

By late afternoon we reach Berat, one of Albania’s most historic and beautiful towns. Known as the “City of a Thousand Windows,” its Ottoman houses cascade down the hillside beneath a hilltop castle.



# BERAT TO DURRES → FERRY TO BARI

## DAY 14

**Start Location: Berat, Albania**  
**End Location: Bari, Italy**  
**Distance: Approx. 60 Miles (plus ferry)**

- Short morning ride to Vlora on the Adriatic
- Evening ferry across to Italy

A slower-paced morning on the bikes today, giving us time to enjoy some of southern Albania's best roads and coastal scenery.

We ride at a relaxed pace, with time for a long, laid-back lunch by the sea.

In the afternoon, we make our way north to Durrës to catch our evening ferry across the Adriatic, settling in for the overnight crossing to Italy.



# BARI → PESCOCOSTANZO

## DAY 15

**Start Location: Bari, Italy**

**End Location: Pescocostanzo, Abruzzo, Italy**

**Distance: Approx. 180 Miles**

- Leave the Adriatic coast behind
- Ride into the Apennine Mountains
- Alpine-style village in the Abruzzo National Park

We wake up and disembark the ferry in Bari around 8am, with time to find a great spot for coffee and breakfast before hitting the road. Leaving the Adriatic coastline behind, we head inland, trading sea views for rolling farmland, quiet villages, and steadily rising mountain roads. Traffic thins, the air cools, and the riding becomes more engaging with every mile.

By midday, the landscape shifts into rugged peaks and forested valleys as we enter the Apennines. Sweeping bends, smooth tarmac, and open mountain views make this a rewarding day in the saddle.

By mid-afternoon, we arrive in Pescocostanzo, a charming stone village set high in the Abruzzo National Park. With cobbled streets and alpine-style architecture, it's the perfect place to unwind, enjoy local food, and relax in the crisp mountain air.

**End Location: Pienza,**  
**Distance: Approx. 210 miles**

**DAY 16**

**PESCOCOSTANZO → PIENZA**

- Cross the Apennine heartland
- Mountain passes and rolling valleys
- Arrival in the Val d'Orcia, Tuscany

We leave the mountains of Abruzzo behind as we ride west across Italy's rural heartland. The route winds through quiet valleys, hill towns, and long open stretches, offering relaxed yet rewarding riding through some of the country's least-travelled regions.

As we approach Tuscany, the scenery softens into rolling hills, vineyards, and cypress-lined ridges. Roads begin to flow more gently, inviting an unhurried pace as classic Tuscan landscapes open up around us.

By mid-afternoon, we arrive in Pienza, a Renaissance hill town overlooking the Val d'Orcia. With sweeping views, golden light, and the scent of pecorino in the air, it's the perfect place to wander, relax, and enjoy one of Italy's most beautiful settings.



**Start Location: Pienza**  
**End Location: Lucca**  
**Distance: Approx. 210 miles**

- Ride through the Val d'Orcia
- Rolling Tuscan hills and vineyards
- Historic walled city of Lucca

We leave Pienza behind with sweeping views across the Val d'Orcia, riding through a postcard-perfect landscape of rolling hills, vineyards, and cypress-lined roads. The early miles are pure Tuscany — smooth tarmac, gentle curves, and endless photo opportunities.

Heading north, the scenery shifts between hill towns, olive groves, and quiet backroads as we work our way toward the western side of the region. The riding remains relaxed and flowing, ideal for soaking up the atmosphere of rural Italy.

By mid-afternoon, we arrive in Lucca, a beautiful walled city known for its tree-lined ramparts and charming old town. Tonight, we explore cobbled streets, lively piazzas, and enjoy great food in one of Tuscany's most elegant towns.

## REST DAY IN LUCCA

# DAY 18

After several big riding days, today is all about slowing the pace and enjoying life in one of Tuscany's most beautiful towns. With no packed schedule, you're free to spend the day exactly how you like.

Many riders choose to stroll or cycle along Lucca's famous city walls, offering great views over the rooftops and surrounding countryside. The historic centre is full of elegant piazzas, independent shops, and shaded cafés — perfect for a relaxed wander.

If you fancy riding, optional loops into the nearby hills or towards the coast offer easy half-day routes. Otherwise, settle in for long lunches, good coffee, and a laid-back evening in this charming walled city.



**Start Location:** Lucca

**End Location:** Courmayeur

**Distance:** Approx. **180 miles**

**Highlights:**

- From Tuscany to the Alps
- Mountain valleys and high passes
- Mont Blanc views in Courmayeur

We leave Lucca behind and head north, riding through rolling countryside before the landscape gradually begins to rise. Quiet backroads, river valleys, and open stretches make for relaxed early miles as we move away from Tuscany.

As we approach northern Italy, the scenery shifts dramatically. Hills turn into mountains, valleys narrow, and alpine peaks begin to dominate the horizon. The roads become more technical and engaging, offering sweeping bends and long climbing sections.

By mid-afternoon, we arrive in Courmayeur, set beneath the towering slopes of Mont Blanc. Surrounded by glaciers and high peaks, this stylish alpine town is the perfect base for our upcoming mountain riding. Tonight, we enjoy crisp mountain air, great food, and spectacular views at the gateway to the Alps.

**Start Location:** Courmateur  
**End Location:** Dijon  
**Distance:** **Approx. 160 miles**

# DAY 20

## COURMAYEUR → DIJON (FRANCE)

- Cross the Western Alps
- Mountain passes and alpine valleys
- Arrival in Burgundy wine country

We leave Courmayeur beneath the towering peaks of Mont Blanc and begin our journey west through the heart of the Alps. The morning brings dramatic scenery, climbing roads, and sweeping mountain views as we cross into France.

Descending into alpine valleys, the route flows through traditional mountain towns and open countryside, with a mix of technical sections and relaxed cruising. It's a rewarding day that blends high passes with fast, scenic stretches.

As the mountains slowly give way to rolling vineyards and farmland, we enter the Burgundy region. By late afternoon, we arrive in Dijon, a historic city at the centre of France's wine country. Tonight, we unwind with great food, local wine, and a relaxed evening in this elegant French town.



# DAY 21

## DIJON → REIMS (FRANCE)

**Start Location:** Dijon

**End Location:** Reims

**Distance:** **Approx. 220 miles**

**Highlights:**

- Ride through Burgundy and Champagne
- Rolling farmland and vineyard roads
- Arrival in historic Reims

We leave Dijon behind and ride north through the heart of rural France, passing rolling farmland, quiet villages, and long open stretches of flowing road. It's a relaxed and enjoyable day, perfect for soaking up the scenery.

As we approach the Champagne region, vineyards begin to line the hillsides and small wine towns appear along the route. The riding remains smooth and unhurried, with plenty of scenic sections through France's most famous wine-growing landscapes.

By mid-afternoon, we arrive in Reims, home to grand champagne houses and an impressive Gothic cathedral. Tonight, there's time to explore the old town, enjoy great food, and perhaps raise a glass to an unforgettable journey.

# DAY 22

**REIMS → FOLKESTONE (UK)**

- Ride through northern France
- Channel crossing back to the UK

We leave Reims behind and head north through rolling countryside and quiet French villages, enjoying the final miles on continental roads. It's an easy, flowing ride that gives everyone time to reflect on the journey so far.

As we approach the Channel coast, anticipation builds for the final crossing back to the UK. After completing border formalities, we cross back to England and roll into Folkestone, bringing our European adventure to a close.

By late afternoon, we arrive back on home soil, marking the end of an unforgettable tour packed with mountains, coastlines, great roads, and brilliant memories. A fitting finish to an epic ride.

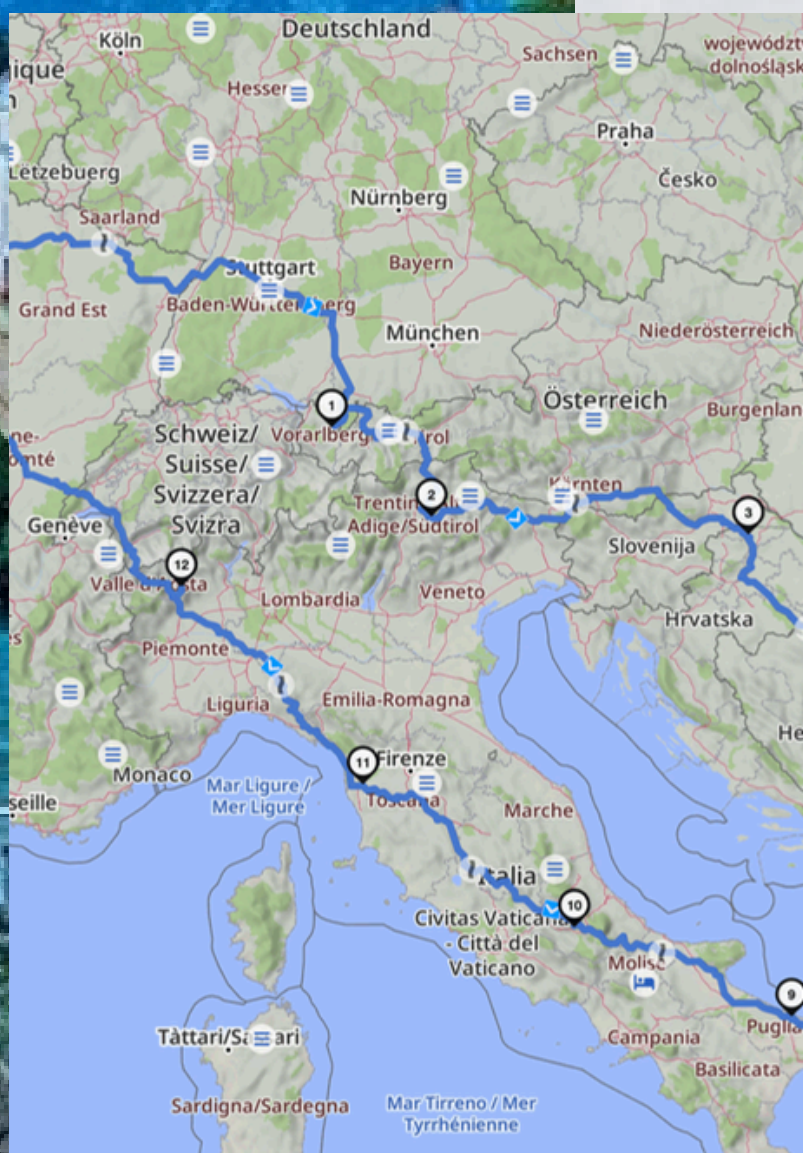

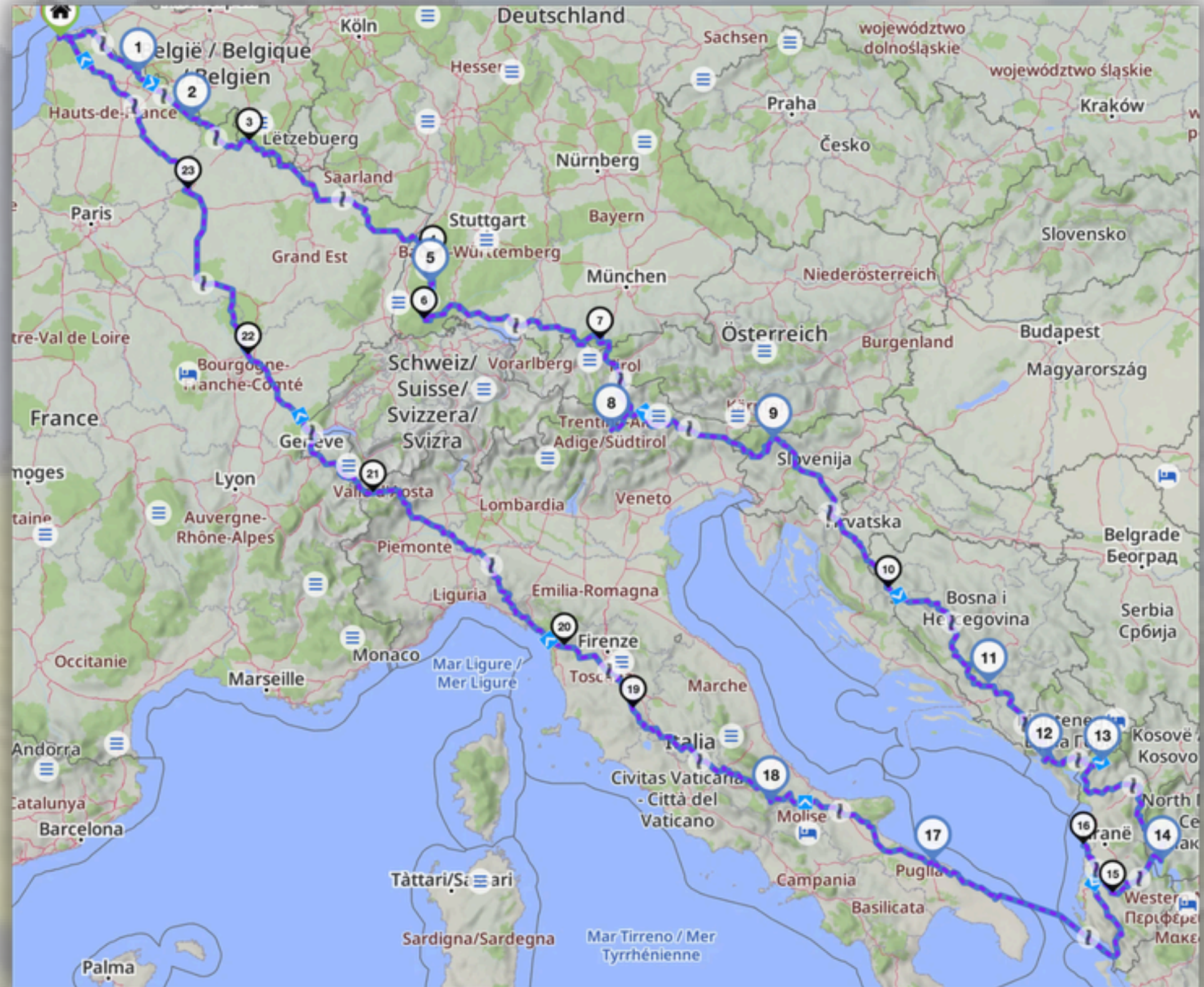
