

INTRODUCING

THE GREAT SPRING RIDE: OLD SPAIN

Set off on a **15-day journey into the heart of Old Spain** — a ride through forgotten roads, historic towns, and landscapes untouched by time.

Depart Plymouth by ferry and arrive in Santander before heading inland, riding through the **wild beauty of the Sierra de Cebollera** to the medieval streets of **Sigüenza**. From there, the route flows south through **La Mancha and into Andalucía's dramatic sierras**, with stays in timeless towns like Almagro.

Turning north, you'll pass through remote regions — from **Guadalupe to the lush mountains of Galicia and Asturias** — before climbing into the towering peaks of the Picos de Europa, home to some of **Spain's best riding**.

The journey finishes in the **Basque Country**, blending coastal roads, culture, and incredible food before looping back to Santander.

A tour defined by epic roads, rich history, and the **real spirit of Spain**.

INTRODUCTION

Welcome to **Wild Roads** — where the ride is as unforgettable as the destination.

This two-week journey is all about shaking off winter and diving straight into the **soul of Spain** — a carefully crafted route through ancient landscapes, forgotten roads, and some of the most authentic regions in Europe.

We begin in Santander, heading inland into the **quiet, rugged beauty of northern Spain** before carving south through remote mountain ranges and historic towns that feel untouched by time. From there, the ride unfolds into **Andalucía** — where **sweeping roads, dramatic scenery, and iconic cities** like Granada deliver a completely different rhythm to the journey.

As we turn west, we ride deep into the heart of **Old Spain** — through vast **open landscapes, medieval villages, and hidden gems like Guadalupe** — before climbing back north into the wild, green hills of **Galicia and Asturias**. Here, the roads tighten, the scenery intensifies, and the riding becomes something truly special.

The final stretch takes us back into the **Picos de Europa** and along the northern coast — a perfect mix of **mountain passes and ocean views** — before returning to Santander for the journey home.

This isn't just a tour — it's a ride through Spain as it once was... **raw, beautiful, and unforgettable.**

PLYMOUTH TO SANTANDER (FERRY CROSSING)

DAY 1

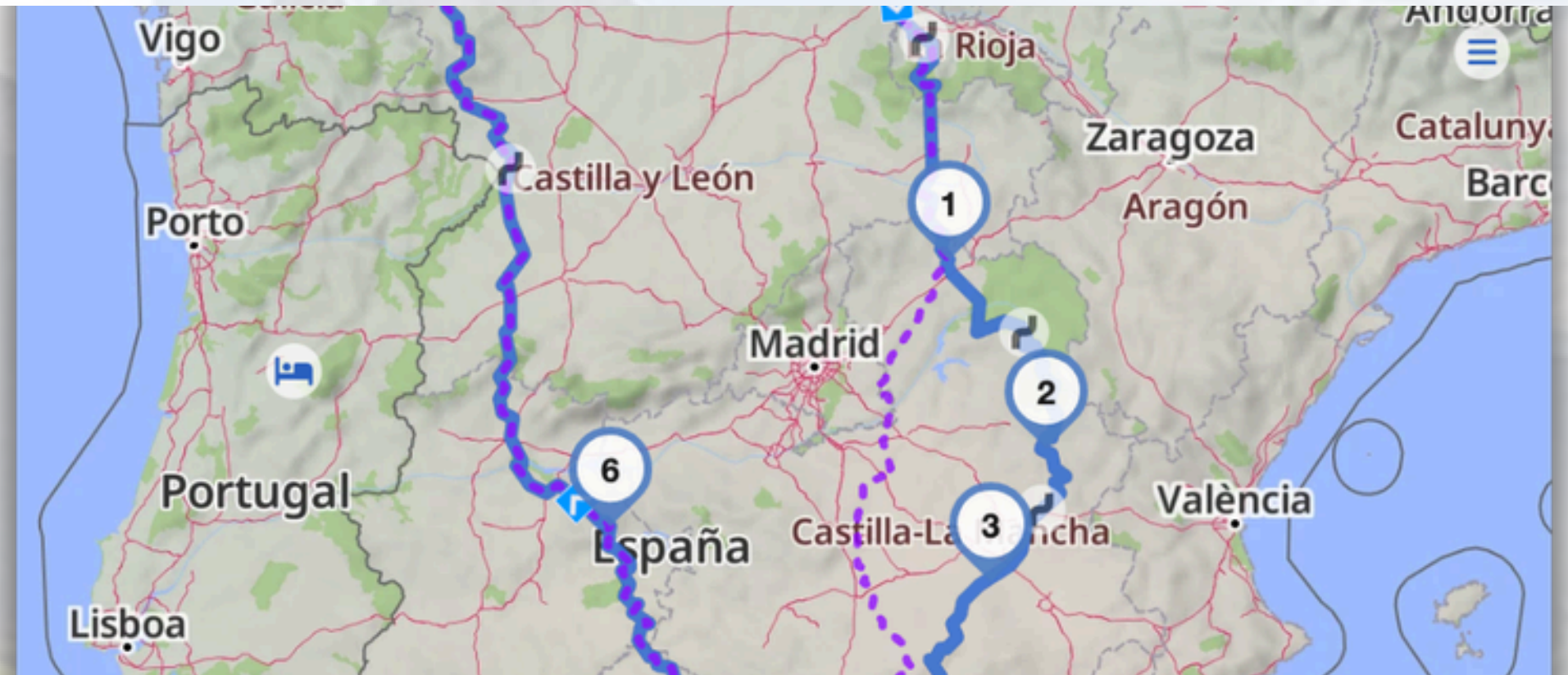
Start Location: Plymouth

End Location: Santander

Distance: Approx: N/A

Highlights:

- Meet the group at Plymouth port
- Boarding Brittany Ferries with private cabins
- First chance to connect with fellow riders
- Onboard dinner, drinks & sea views
- Tour briefing & route overview



After meeting at the port in Plymouth, we get everyone checked in and ready to roll aboard the overnight ferry to Spain. This is where the journey really begins — not just the miles, but the people you'll be riding with over the next two weeks.

Once onboard, there's time to settle into your private cabin, grab some food, and head out on deck as we leave the UK behind. Spirits are high, anticipation builds, and the conversations start flowing.

We'll run through a relaxed tour briefing over dinner or drinks — covering the route, what to expect, and getting everyone dialled in for the adventure ahead.

By the time we wake up, we'll be in Spain... ready to ride.

SANTANDER TO SIGÜENZA

DAY 2/3

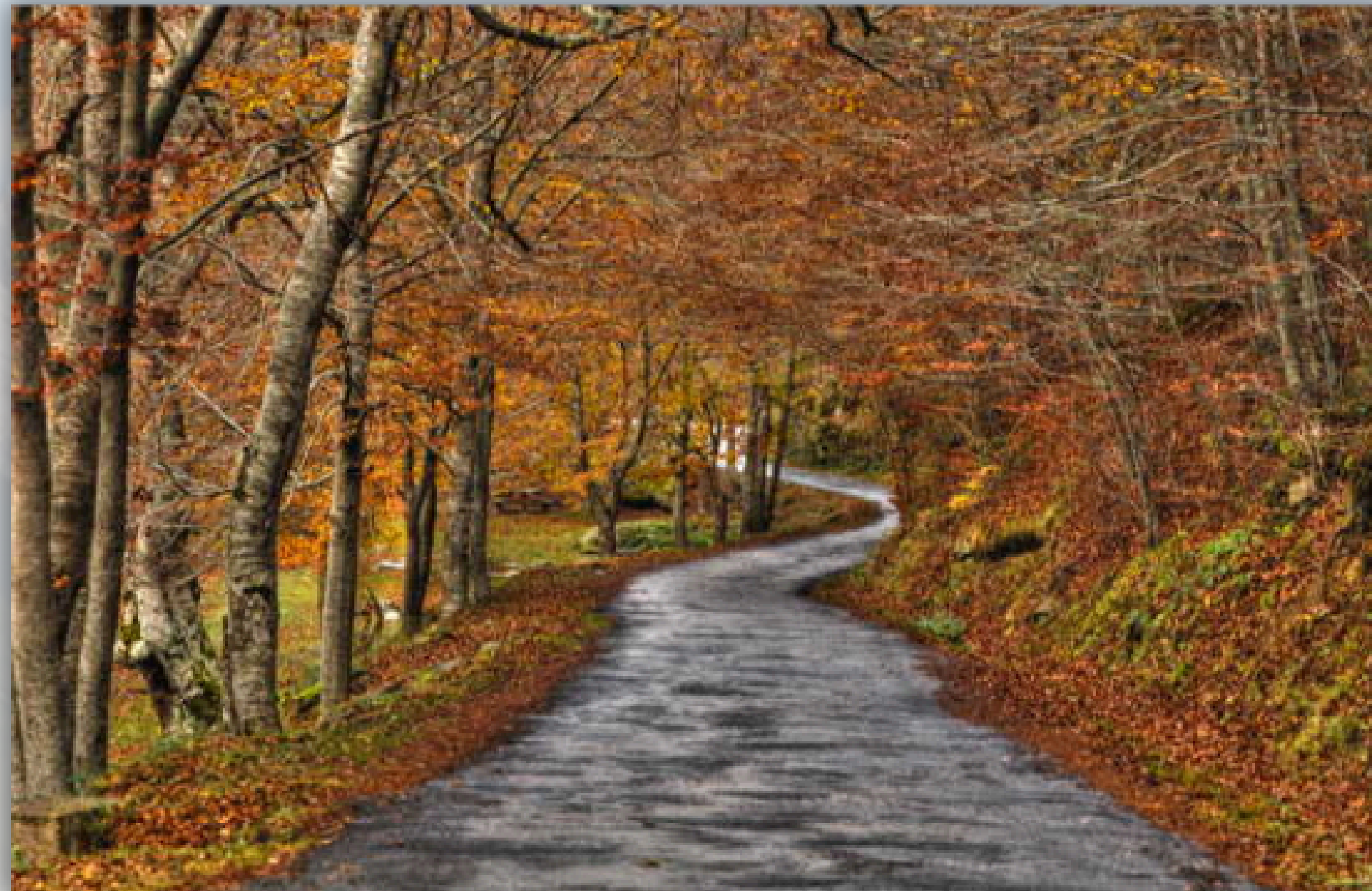
Start Location: Santander

End Location: Sigüenza

Distance: Approx: 180–220 Miles

Highlights:

- First ride into Spain
- Cantabrian Mountains scenery
- Quiet, flowing backroads
- Transition from green north to central Spain
- Historic medieval town of Sigüenza



We roll off the ferry into Santander around early afternoon — straight onto Spanish tarmac and into the rhythm of the ride.

The first section takes us inland through the lush, green landscapes of northern Spain before gradually shifting into something drier, more open, and unmistakably “Old Spain”.

The roads begin to open up — long sweepers, quiet stretches, and that feeling of space that makes riding here so special.

By evening, we arrive in Sigüenza — a beautifully preserved medieval town dominated by its hilltop castle. It’s the perfect first night on Spanish soil: relaxed, atmospheric, and a proper taste of what’s to come.

SIGÜENZA TO ALMAGRO

DAY 4

Start Location: Sigüenza

End Location: Almagro

Distance: Approx. 150–180 Miles

Highlights:

- Deep ride into Castilla-La Mancha
- Rolling plains & endless horizons
- Quiet, untouched roads
- Stay in a historic Parador
- Explore Almagro's old-world charm



Today we head deeper into the heart of Spain — into landscapes that feel vast, raw, and completely different to the north.

This is proper Old Spain riding. Big skies, open roads, and a sense of calm that's hard to find anywhere else in Europe.

The riding is smooth and flowing, giving you time to settle fully into the trip — finding your rhythm, your pace, and your connection with the road.

We arrive in Almagro, a hidden gem packed with history and character. Tonight's stay is something special — a traditional Parador, offering a unique blend of heritage, comfort, and atmosphere.

ALMAGRO TO GRANADA

DAY 5

Start Location: Almagro

End Location: Granada

Distance: Approx. 220 Miles

Highlights:

- Ride through Sierra de Cazorla Natural Park
- Long sweeping mountain roads
- Changing landscapes throughout the day
- Arrival into Granada
- Views of the Sierra Nevada

Today is where things really start to level up.

We trade open plains for mountains as we carve through one of Spain's most stunning natural regions — the Sierra de Cazorla. Expect flowing bends, elevation changes, and miles of uninterrupted riding.

This is one of those days where the road just keeps giving.

By late afternoon, we descend into Granada — one of Spain's most iconic cities, sitting beneath the towering Sierra Nevada mountains.

The contrast is incredible: wild nature to rich culture in a single day.

DAY 6

Start Location: Granada

End Location: Granada

Distance: Approx: Optional Ride Day

Highlights:

- Optional ride into Sierra Nevada
- Explore the Alhambra & historic city
- Tapas, culture & Andalusian atmosphere
- Relax and recharge
- Flexible day to ride or unwind



Today is yours.

You can take the bike out for an unforgettable ride into the Sierra Nevada — higher altitude roads, cooler air, and incredible views.

Or slow things down and explore Granada itself. The Alhambra, the old streets, the food — this place has a completely different energy to anywhere we've been so far.

It's also the perfect chance to reset, recharge, and soak it all in before we continue deeper into the journey.

GRANADA TO GUADALUPE

DAY 7

Start Location: Granada

End Location: Guadalupe

Distance: Approx: 200–230 Miles

Highlights:

- Rolling out of Andalucía
- Wide-open Spanish countryside
- Quiet, untouched backroads
- Arrival into historic Guadalupe
- Monastery views & old-world atmosphere



We leave Granada behind and head west, transitioning once again into a completely different side of Spain.

The roads stretch out, the traffic disappears, and the landscape opens into that raw, authentic “Old Spain” feel — vast, quiet, and deeply atmospheric.

This is a proper riding day. Long, flowing sections mixed with smaller, forgotten roads that feel like they haven’t changed in decades.

By evening, we arrive in Guadalupe — a stunning historic town centred around its famous monastery. It’s one of those places that feels frozen in time... and the perfect setting to unwind after a big day in the saddle.

GUADALUPE TO SOUTH GALICIA

DAY 8

Start Location: Guadalupe

End Location: Southern Galicia

Distance: Approx. 220–260 Miles

Highlights:

- Remote cross-country ride north
- Endless flowing roads with minimal traffic
- Changing scenery throughout the day
- Entering lush, green Galicia
- True off-the-tourist-track experience



Today is all about the journey.

We push north across some of Spain's most overlooked regions — riding roads that are quiet, smooth, and seemingly built just for us.

The terrain evolves throughout the day — dry, rugged landscapes slowly giving way to greener hills as we approach Galicia.

It's a long ride, but one of those deeply satisfying days where you feel like you've truly travelled across a country.

We finish in southern Galicia — a region known for its wild beauty, cooler air, and incredible riding roads.

SOUTH GALICIA TO VILLANUEVA DE OSCOS

DAY 9

Start Location: Southern Galicia

End Location: Villanueva de Oscos

Distance: 150–180 Miles

Ride Options:

- Twistier, more technical roads
- Deep green valleys & forest riding
- Entering Asturias
- Stay at biker-favourite Hotel Oscos
- Legendary local biker bar



The riding changes again today — and this is where it gets fun.

We leave behind the longer open roads and dive into tighter, more technical riding through Galicia and into Asturias. Think endless corners, rolling hills, and lush green surroundings.

This is pure rider's territory.

Our destination is Villanueva de Oscos — home to one of the most iconic biker stops in northern Spain. The atmosphere here is unbeatable, with riders from all over Europe passing through.

Tonight is all about good food, a few drinks, and proper biker camaraderie.

VILLANUEVA DE OSCOS TO POTES (PICOS DE EUROPA)

DAY 10

Start Location: Villanueva de Oscos

End Location: Potes

Distance: Approx. 180 Miles

Highlights:

- Stunning Asturian mountain roads
- Transition back into the Picos de Europa
- Dramatic scenery & elevation changes
- River valleys & cliffside riding
- Arrival into Potes



Today delivers some of the most spectacular riding of the trip.

We head east through Asturias, carving through mountain roads that feel purpose-built for motorcycling — a perfect mix of flow, scenery, and technical sections.

As the day unfolds, the peaks begin to rise again... and before long, we're back in the legendary Picos de Europa.

We roll into Potes — a firm Wild Roads favourite — surrounded by towering mountains and packed with character.

POTES (EXPLORE & RIDE DAY)

DAY 11

End Location: Potes

Distance: Optional Ride Day

Highlights:

- Ride the famous Fuente Dé road
- Optional mountain loops in the Picos
- Cable car views over the peaks

Today is all about enjoying the Picos.

You can head out for another incredible ride — tackling some of the best roads in the region, including the iconic climb to Fuente Dé.

Or take it slower, explore Potes, grab some food, and soak in the mountain atmosphere.

This is one of those places riders always remember — and today gives you time to fully experience it.

POTES TO ARGOMANIZ (BASQUE REGION)

DAY 12

Start Location: Potes

End Location: Argomaniz

Distance: Approx. 150–180 Miles

Highlights:

- Final ride through the Picos
- Transition into the Basque Country
- Smooth, flowing roads
- Changing culture & architecture
- Stay in a historic Parador



We leave the mountains behind — but not before one last incredible ride through the Picos.

From there, we head east into the Basque Country, where everything subtly shifts — the scenery, the buildings, the culture. The roads here are smooth, flowing, and incredibly satisfying to ride.

Tonight we stay in Argomaniz, in another stunning historic Parador — combining comfort, history, and a proper end-of-journey feel as the trip begins to wind down.

ARGOMANIZ TO LEKEITIO (BASQUE COAST LOOP)

DAY 13

Start Location: Argomaniz

End Location: Lekeitio

Distance: Approx. 120–150 Miles

Highlights:

- Basque Country mountain roads
- Coastal riding along the Bay of Biscay
- Cliffside views & ocean air
- Pintxos & seaside atmosphere
- Stay in Lekeitio



Today is pure variety.

We ride through the rolling hills of the Basque interior before dropping down to the coastline — where the roads hug the cliffs and the Atlantic stretches out beside you.

This is a completely different riding experience again — tighter roads, dramatic views, and that fresh ocean air.

We finish in Lekeitio, a beautiful coastal town known for its laid-back vibe, great food, and classic Basque charm.

LEKEITIO TO SANTANDER

DAY 14

Start Location: Lekeitio

End Location: Santander

Distance: Approx. 120–150 Miles

Highlights:

- Final coastal ride west
- Smooth, scenic A-roads
- Last group ride moments
- Return to Santander
- Farewell dinner



Our final riding day brings everything together.

We follow the coastline west, enjoying one last stretch of incredible riding — a mix of flowing roads, sea views, and relaxed cruising. It's a chance to reflect on the journey, enjoy the final miles, and soak in the experience one last time.

Back in Santander, we wrap things up with a proper farewell meal — good food, good company, and plenty of stories from the road.
