INTRODUCTION

Welcome to **Wild Roads** — where the ride is the destination.

This **19-day adventure** takes you across Spain and deep into Morocco, crossing mountains, deserts, and cities that feel frozen in time. From the Gothic cathedrals of Burgos to the blue-washed streets of **Chefchaouen**, from the vast Sahara dunes of **Merzouga** to the chaos of **Marrakech**, this is a ride that captures the spirit of two continents.

It's not a sightseeing holiday — it's a bucket-list journey across some of the most legendary roads in **Europe and Africa**. Expect ferry crossings, endless mountain switchbacks, desert horizons, and handpicked overnight stays that keep the adventure alive both on and off the bike.

We kick off in northern Spain, drop south through **Andalucía**, then cross the **Strait of Gibraltar** into Morocco. From there, it's a whirlwind of **imperial cities**, **kasbahs**, **High Atlas passes**, and Sahara sands before looping back to Spain's green mountains and returning to the UK.

This is a bold mix of history, landscapes, and pure riding — built for riders who want more than just another tour.

UK TO SOUTHERN SPAIN

Start Location: Plymouth

End Location: Granada, Spain

Distance: **Approx. 550 Miles (over 3 riding days + ferry)**

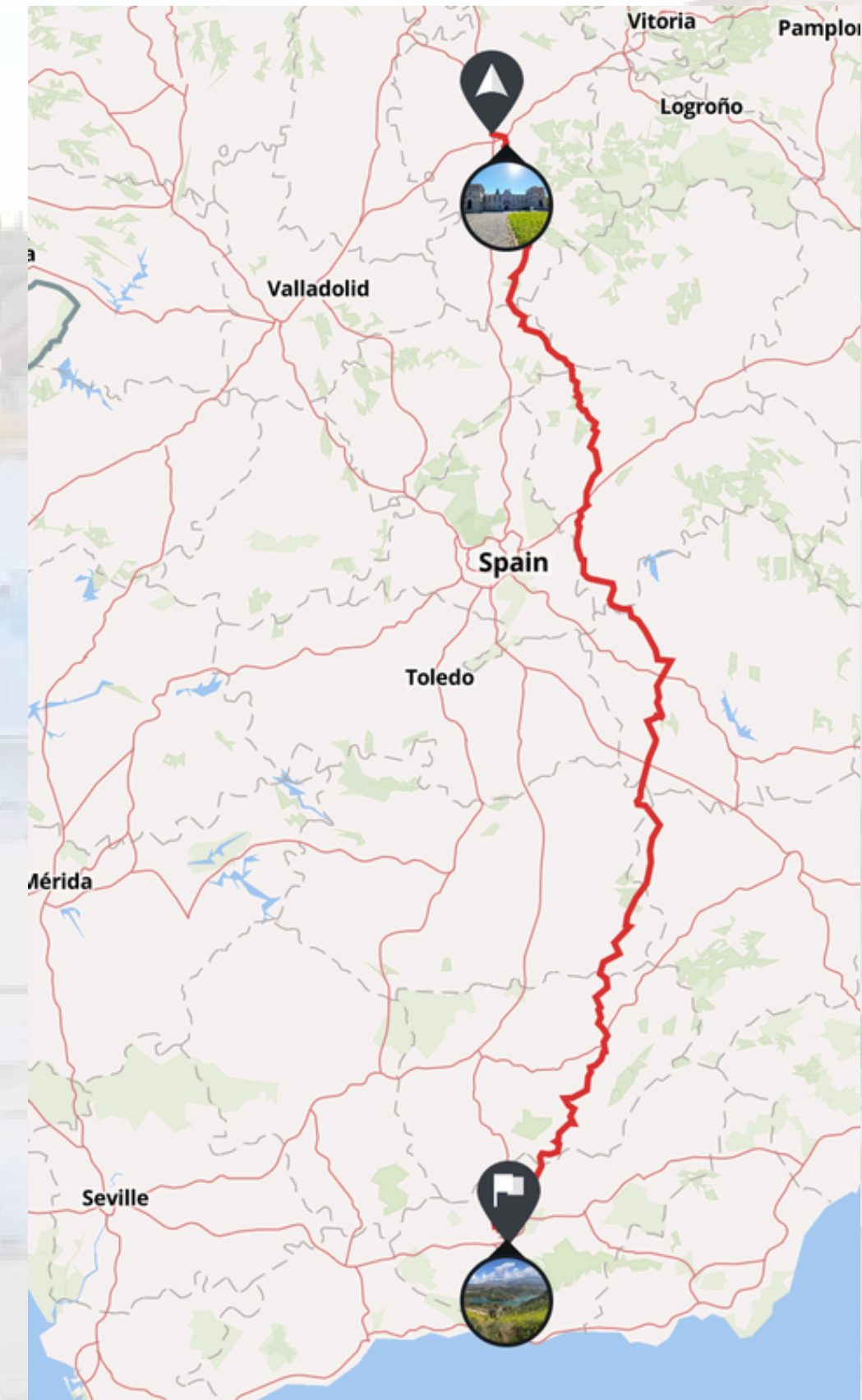
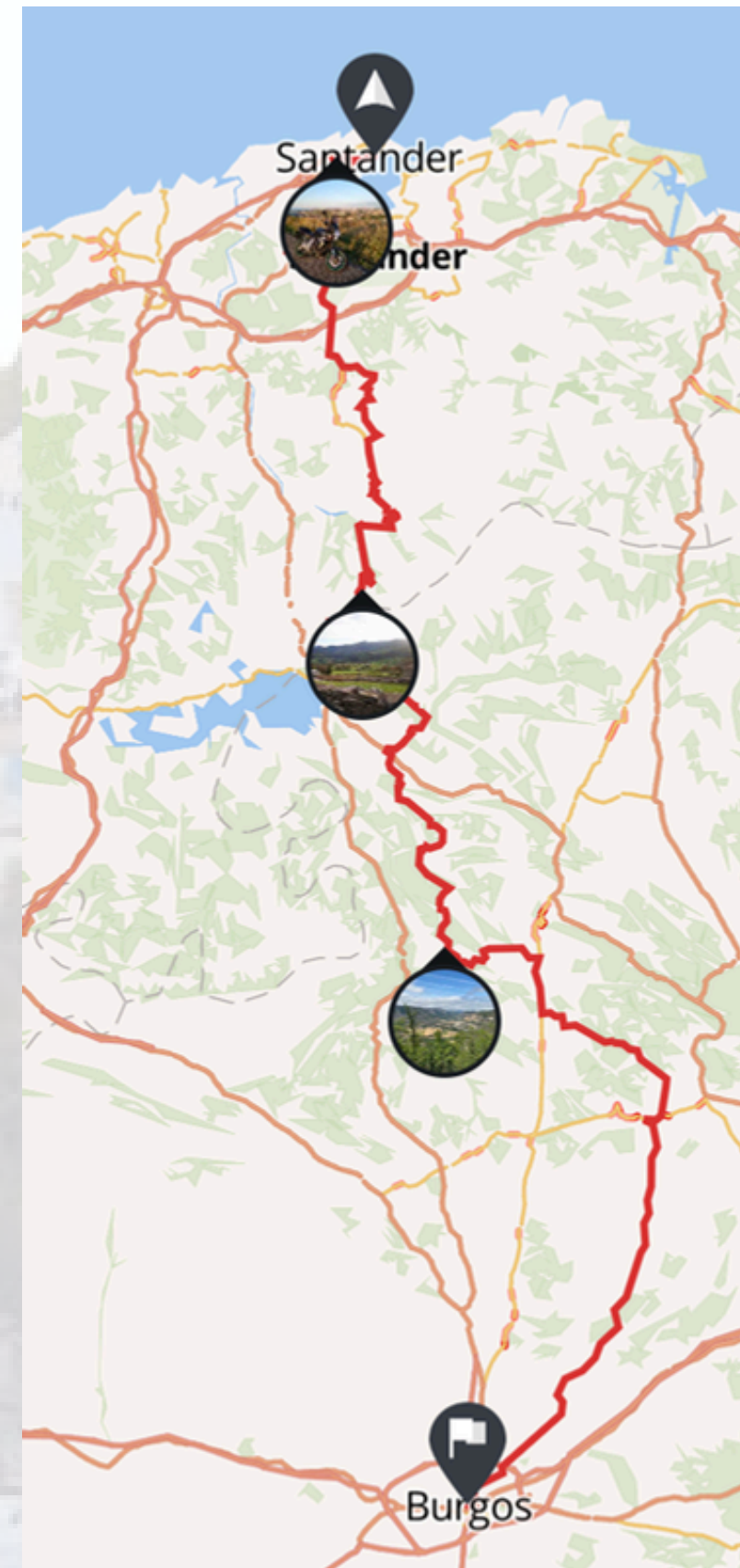
Highlights:

- Rolling Cantabrian hills & Castilla's open plains
- Gothic splendour of Burgos
- Vineyards & windmills of La Mancha

The journey begins as we sail from Plymouth across the Bay of Biscay, a night on the ferry spent sharing stories and building the anticipation of the road ahead. By morning, Spain is under our wheels. From the lush Cantabrian hills we ride into Burgos, a city of Gothic spires and medieval streets.

Heading south, the landscape opens wide — endless horizons, vineyards, and the famous windmills of La Mancha. It's classic Spain: vast skies, sweeping roads, and a sense of freedom that grows with every mile. Our stop in Ciudad Real roots us in Don Quixote country, a land where legends still feel alive.

From there, the road climbs towards the Sierra Nevada, the mountains rising in the distance as we drop into Granada. Here, the Alhambra crowns the skyline, tapas bars spill into narrow lanes, and the rhythm of Andalucía begins to stir. It's the perfect gateway to the adventure that lies beyond — Morocco awaits.



CROSSING INTO MOROCCO & THE ROAD TO THE DESERT

Start Location: Granada

End Location: Errachidia, Morocco

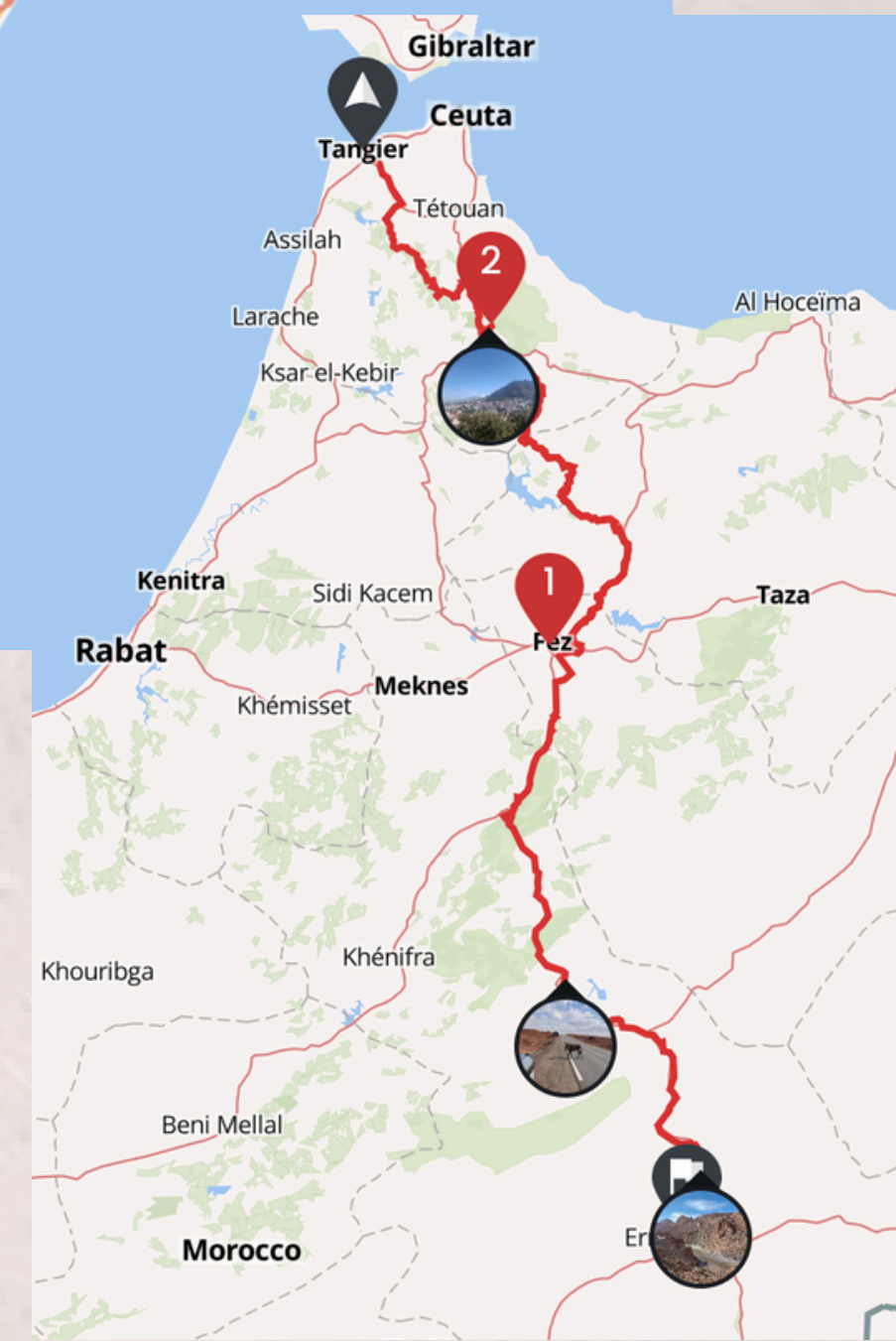
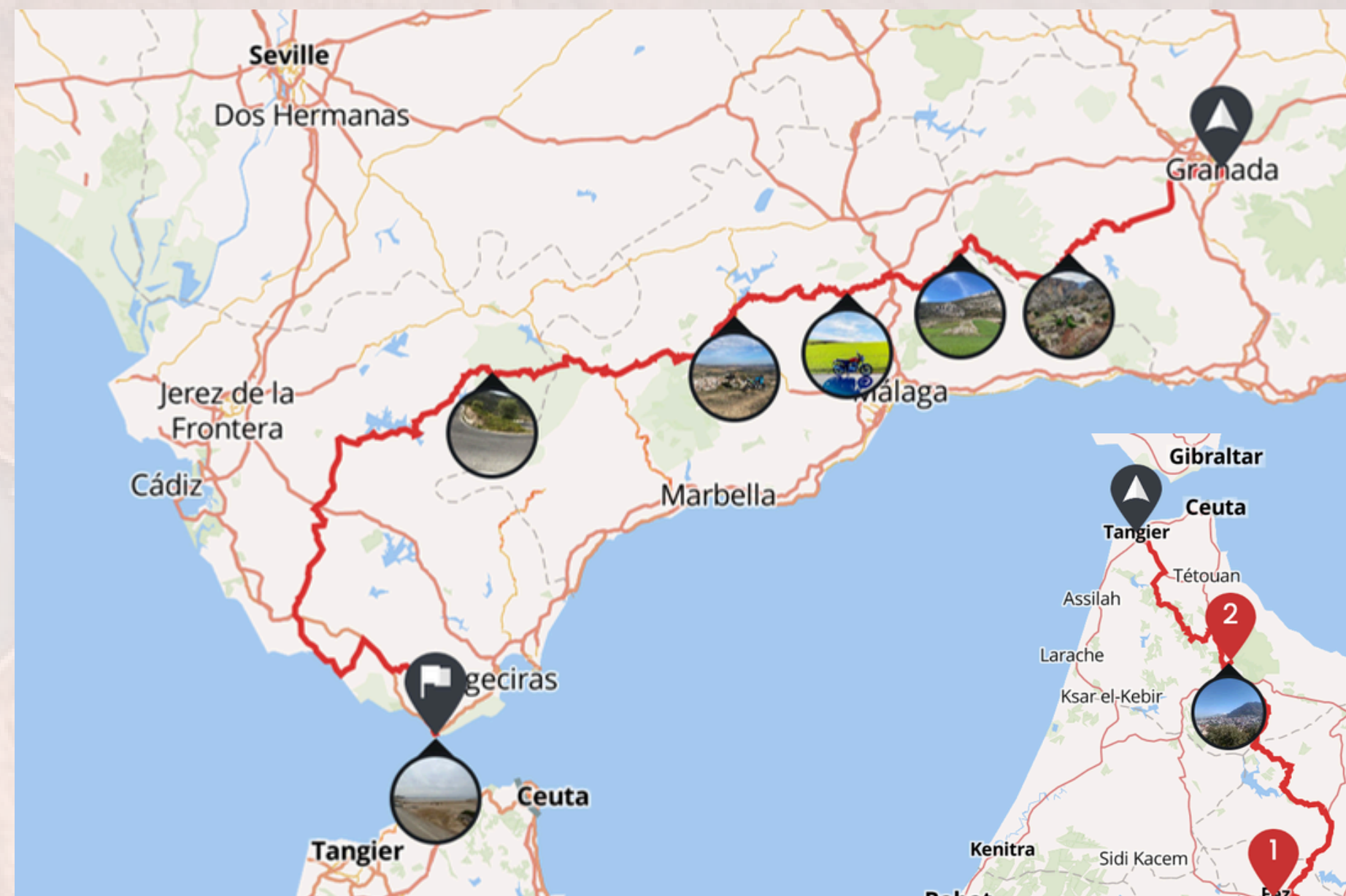
Distance: 700 miles (over 4 riding days + rest day)

From Granada, the road sweeps south through Andalucía, winding past olive groves and coastal hills until we reach Tarifa, Europe's southern tip where the Atlantic meets the Mediterranean. The air feels electric — Morocco is just across the water.

The next morning we ferry across the Strait of Gibraltar, trading Europe for Africa in under an hour. From Tangier, the road climbs into the Rif Mountains, delivering us to Chefchaouen, Morocco's famous Blue City, where painted alleyways glow under the mountain light.

We push further inland to the ancient imperial capital of Fez, its labyrinthine medina alive with colours, spices, and centuries-old craft. After a rest day to absorb its energy — or take a short ride-out into the surrounding hills — we point our wheels towards the desert.

The ride over the Middle Atlas is a journey through cedar forests and high plateaus before the landscape begins to change. The air dries, the horizon stretches, and by the time we reach Errachidia, we are on the very edge of the Sahara. The desert is calling.



SAHARA SANDS & THE HIGH ATLAS

Start Location: Errachidia, Morocco

End Location: Marrakech, Morocco

Distance: **Approx. 500 miles (over 4 riding days + 1 rest day)**

From Errachidia, the road follows the Ziz Valley, carved deep through red cliffs and palm oases, until the desert opens before us. By the end of the day we reach Merzouga, perched on the edge of the mighty Erg Chebbi dunes. Golden sands stretch to the horizon — a breathtaking sight.

We spend a full day here in the desert, with time to explore on two wheels, take a camel trek at sunset, or simply relax at the lodge before the night sky explodes with stars. Few places on earth feel as vast and timeless.

The journey continues west through kasbah villages and desert valleys, leading us to the ancient ksar of Ait Benhaddou — a fortress of clay and stone that has starred in countless films. It's a place where history and myth seem to merge.



From here, the road climbs the legendary Tizi n'Tichka Pass through the High Atlas. Switchback after switchback delivers us to the bustling chaos of Marrakech, Morocco's Red City. By night, the Jemaa el-Fnaa square comes alive with food stalls, music, and storytellers — a true sensory overload.

A rest day follows, giving us the chance to wander Marrakech's souks, palaces, and gardens, or simply sip mint tea on a rooftop terrace overlooking the city.

FROM MARRAKECH TO NORTHERN SPAIN

Start Location: Marrakech, Morocco

End Location: Zamora, Spain

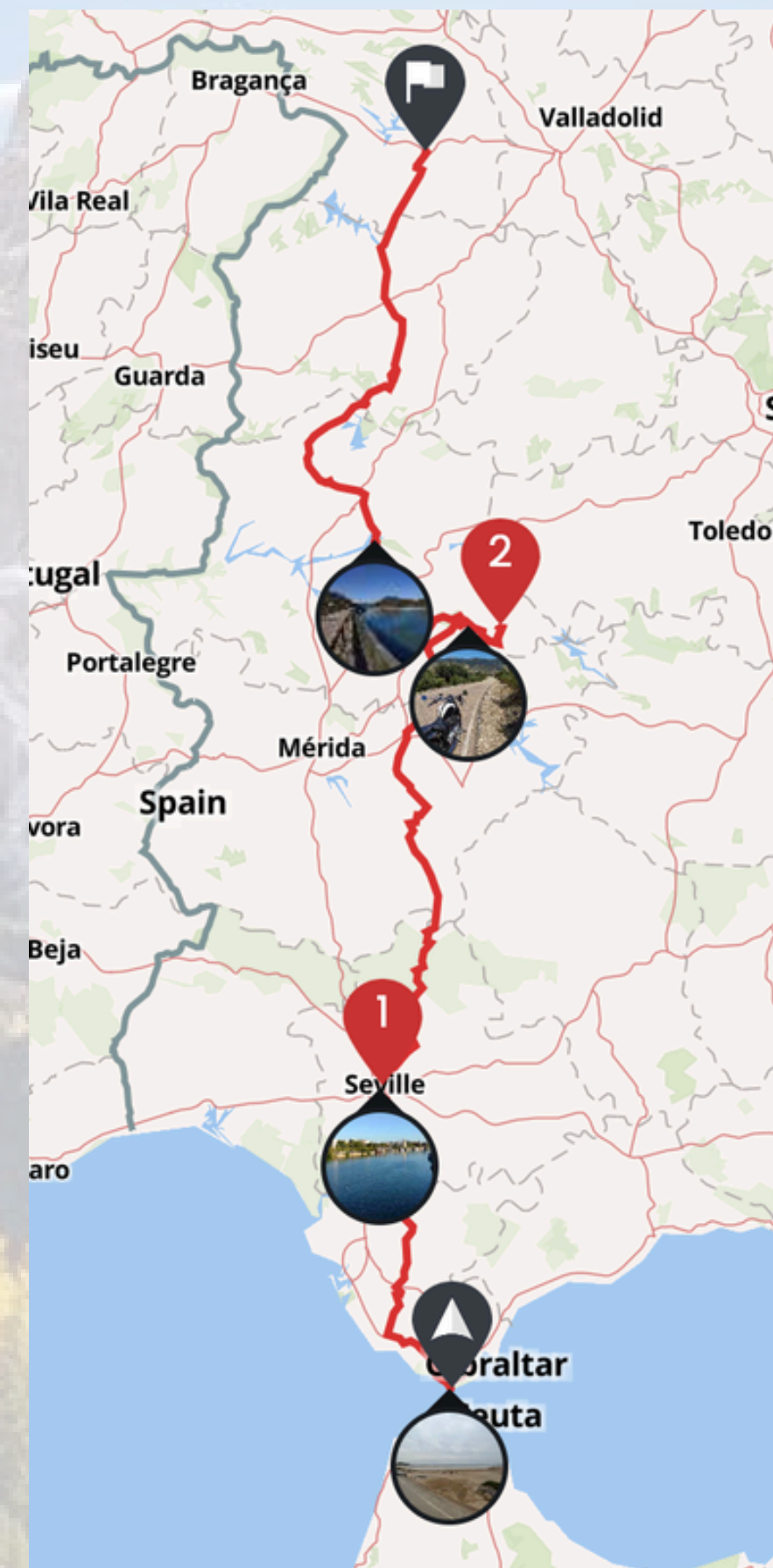
Distance: **Approx. 850 miles (over 4 riding days)**

From the chaos and colour of Marrakech, we turn north, riding towards Morocco's quieter side. By evening, we roll into Rabat, the nation's capital, where ocean breezes, kasbah walls, and Andalusian gardens create a calmer rhythm before crossing back to Europe.

The next day, we board the ferry across the Strait of Gibraltar, leaving Africa behind as the bikes touch Spanish soil once more. From the coast we head inland, trading sea views for olive groves and rolling hills, before arriving in vibrant Sevilla — a city alive with flamenco rhythms, Moorish architecture, and sun-drenched plazas. The perfect place to celebrate our return to Spain.

From here, the road winds inland into Extremadura's rolling hills, delivering us to Guadalupe. Cobbled streets and a vast monastery define this charming town, offering a peaceful stop in the heart of Spain.

We continue north through wide Castilian landscapes to Zamora, perched on the banks of the River Duero. With its Romanesque churches, hearty food, and excellent wine, it's a place made for slowing down and enjoying the simple pleasures after a long ride.



THE PICOS & HOMEWARD BOUND

Start Location: Zamora

End Location: UK

Distance: **Approx. 450 miles (over 2 riding days + ferry)**

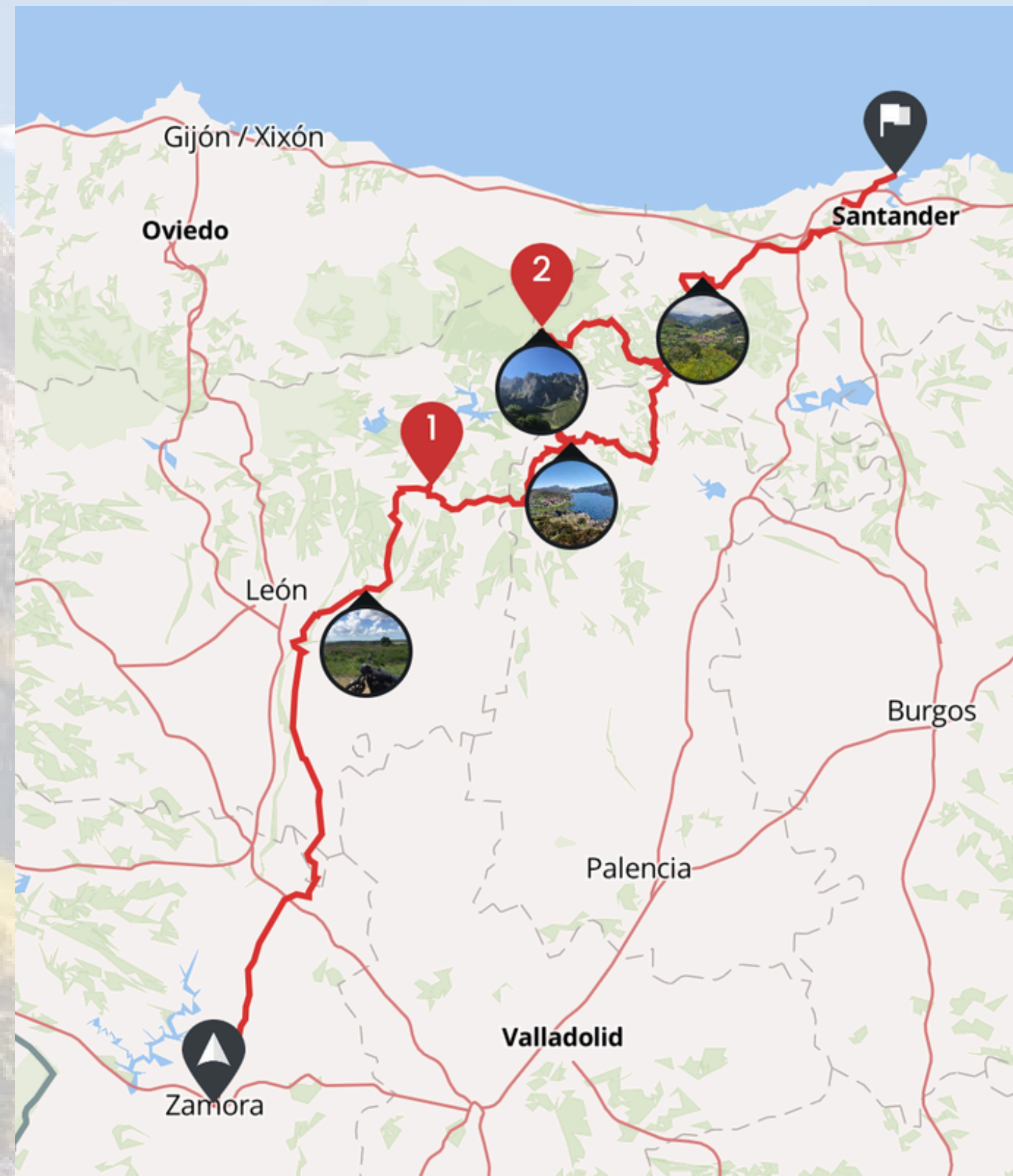
Highlights:

- Epic finale ride into the Picos de Europa
- Overnight stay beneath the cliffs of Fuente Dé
- Final coastal ride into Santander

Leaving Zamora, the road carries us north into the jagged beauty of the Picos de Europa. The climb into Fuente Dé is a rider's dream — twisting roads, towering cliffs, and valleys that open into some of Spain's most breathtaking scenery. It's a spectacular setting for our final night on the road.

On our final days, we descend from the mountains and ride the last stretch back to Santander. The Cantabrian coast greets us once more as we roll onto the ferry, the bikes secured below deck for the journey home. Over dinner, there's time to share stories, laughter, and memories of two continents conquered on two wheels.

As the ship docks and we roll off together, the scale of the adventure sets in — from Spain's cathedrals to Morocco's desert, from mountain passes to endless plains. The road has been long, but unforgettable.

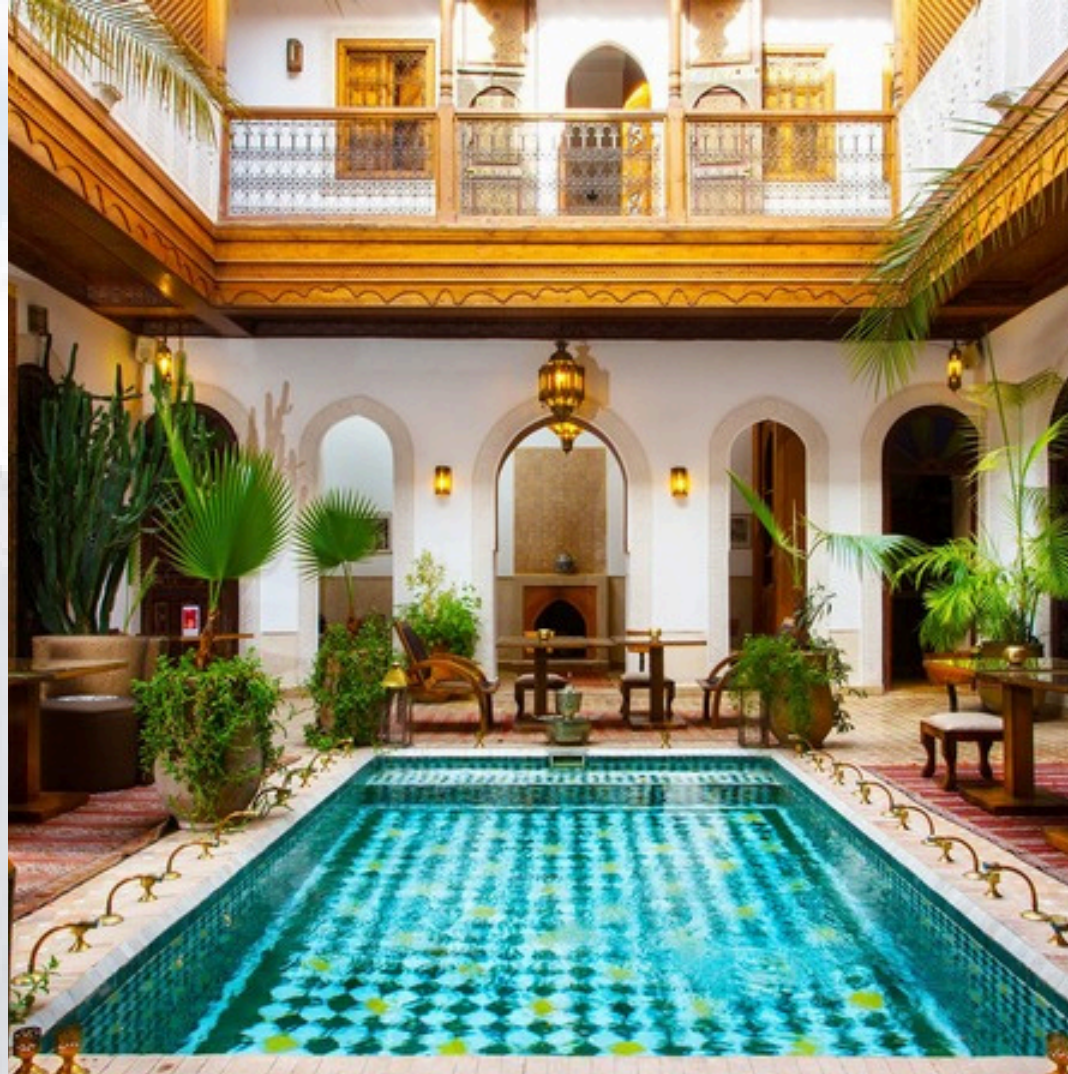

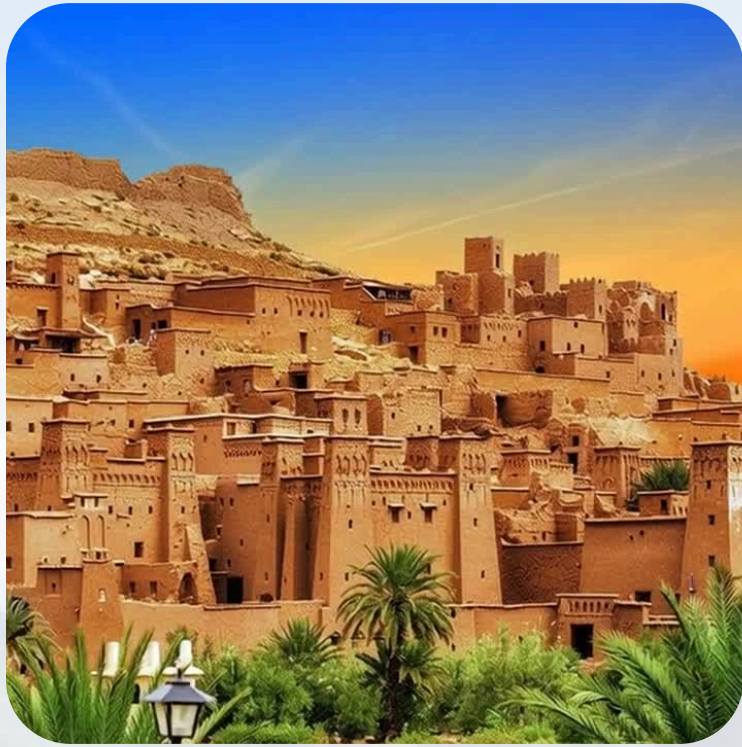
