FOLKESTONE TO ARDENNES REGION

DAY 1

Start Location: Folkestone

End Location: Ardennes, Belgium

Distance: Approx. **200 Miles**

Highlights:

- Channel Tunnel crossing
- Cruise through northern France
- Rolling countryside & forested roads
- Warm-up ride into the Ardennes region

After a smooth and hassle-free tunnel crossing, riders roll off the train tracks and onto the wide, open roads of northern France. It's an easy-going first day designed to let everyone settle into the rhythm of the adventure at their own pace. Quiet villages, open farmland, and flowing backroads create the perfect introduction to life on the continent.

As the Belgian border approaches, the scenery begins to shift. Flat plains slowly give way to winding country lanes, rolling hills, and the deep green forests of the Ardennes. The roads start to flow a little more, the corners tighten gently, and the ride begins to come alive.

Some riders will naturally pair up along the way, while others may disappear into the roads solo for a few peaceful hours. That's the beauty of the Open Road Collective — complete freedom to experience the journey your own way, while still sharing the adventure with others.

By late afternoon, everyone arrives at our first overnight stop hidden deep within the Ardennes forest. A cold beer on the terrace, stories from the road, and the relaxed atmosphere of the group set the tone for the days ahead.



ARDENNES REGION TO BLACK FOREST

DAY 2

Start Location: Ardennes

End Location: Black Forest, Germany

Distance: Approx. **240 Miles**

Highlights:

- Cross Belgium, Luxembourg & Germany
- Stop for coffee in Luxembourg City
- Enter the legendary Schwarzwald (Black Forest)
- Forest roads, winding corners, and panoramic views

Today's ride is a true continental sweep — three countries, one day and a whole lot of curves in between. Riders leave the Ardennes and weave through misty forests, shaded lanes, and quiet villages as the roads gradually begin to open up.

Luxembourg comes and goes in a blink, but the riding here is superb — smooth sweepers, rolling ridgelines, river valleys, and postcard-perfect villages tucked into the hills. Some riders may stop for long coffees and photos along the way, while others continue carving through the bends ahead.

From there, the route pushes east into Germany and deep into the legendary Black Forest. Dense pine trees line the roads as the riding becomes faster, twistier, and more immersive. Timber-framed villages and roadside cafés appear around almost every corner, making it impossible not to stop and soak it all in.

By evening, everyone rolls into our lodge hidden deep amongst the trees. The bikes are warm, the beers are cold, and the terrace quickly fills with stories from another brilliant day on the road.



BLACK FOREST TO GARMISCH-PARTENKIRCHEN

DAY 3

Start Location: Black Forest

End Location: Garmisch-Partenkirchen, Bavaria

Distance: Approx. **190 Miles**

Highlights:

- Scenic ride along the edge of the Alps
- Rolling Bavarian countryside & winding valley roads
- Historic towns & timber-framed villages
- Beer halls, mountains & alpine charm

We break camp in the heart of the Black Forest and head southeast towards the Alps, leaving the dark pine corridors behind as the landscape gradually opens into rolling valleys, winding rivers, and sweeping Bavarian roads. It's a relaxed riding day designed to let everyone settle into the rhythm of the journey.

The Bavarian countryside feels almost storybook-like — red-roofed villages, onion-domed churches, rustic roadside inns, and mountain peaks slowly growing larger on the horizon. Stops along the way might include a lakeside bratwurst, a quiet village café, or simply pulling over to soak in the scenery for a while.

By late afternoon, riders roll into Garmisch-Partenkirchen — a beautiful alpine town sitting beneath the towering peaks of southern Germany. Classic beer halls, hearty Bavarian food, cobbled streets, and mountain views from every direction make this a brilliant place to spend the evening before the real mountain riding begins.



GARMISCH-PARTENKIRCHEN TO BOLZANO (SOUTH TYROL)

DAY 4

Start Location: Black Forest

End Location: Garmisch-Partenkirchen, Bavaria

Distance: Approx. **190 Miles**

Highlights:

- Ride through Germany, Austria, and into Italy
- Scenic climbs and dramatic alpine views
- Cross alpine passes with sweeping switchbacks
- Arrive in Bolzano — gateway to the Dolomites

Today the real mountain riding begins as you leave Germany behind and head south into the Alps. The roads tighten, the scenery becomes more dramatic, and towering peaks begin to surround the route from every direction.

You'll cross into Austria before climbing higher towards Italy, carving through flowing alpine passes, deep valleys, and picture-perfect mountain villages. Stops along the way might include coffee beside crystal-clear lakes or simply pulling over to take in the scale of the scenery around you.

By evening, you roll into Bolzano — a beautiful alpine town where Austrian and Italian culture blend together beneath the jagged peaks of the Dolomites.



DOLOMITE DAY LOOP RIDE (PASS BLITZ!)

DAY 5

Start Location: Garmisch-Partenkirchen

End Location: Bolzano, Italy

Distance: Approx. **240 Miles**

Highlights:

- Ride the legendary Sella Ronda loop
- Conquer Passo Pordoi, Gardena, Sella & Giau
- Epic Dolomite vistas & high-altitude villages

Today is all about the Dolomites.

Expect an unforgettable day of world-class mountain riding as the route loops through legendary passes, dramatic rock formations, and endless sweeping bends. The roads here are some of the best in Europe — flowing effortlessly between towering cliffs, alpine meadows, and traditional mountain villages.

Some riders may spend hours chasing perfect corners, while others take a slower approach, stopping for photos, coffee, and mountain lunches along the way.

Either way, this is a day that stays with you forever.



BOLZANO TO BOLOGNA

DAY 6

Start Location: Bolzano, Italy

End Location: Bologna

Distance: Approx. **190 Miles**

Highlights:

- Descend from the Dolomites into the Italian plains
- Ride through Trentino's apple orchards and vineyards
- Scenic sweepers and motorway freedom
- Arrive in Bologna — Italy's food capital

Leaving the mountains behind, today's ride flows south through northern Italy as the dramatic alpine scenery slowly softens into rolling countryside and wide open valleys.

The roads remain superb — fast sweepers, flowing curves, and endless opportunities to simply enjoy the rhythm of riding through Italy.

As you approach Bologna, the atmosphere shifts completely. Medieval streets, incredible food, lively cafés, and authentic Italian energy make this one of the most vibrant stops of the entire journey.



BOLOGNA TO FLORENCE (HALF-DAY RIDE)

DAY 7

Start Location: Bologna

End Location: Florence

Distance: Approx. **80 miles**

Highlights:

- Cross the Apennine Mountains
- Ride one of Italy's most scenic lesser-known passes
- Midday arrival into Florence
- Free afternoon for museums, markets & rooftop views

Today is a shorter ride through the heart of northern Tuscany, giving you time to slow things down slightly and properly enjoy the journey.

The route winds through rolling hills, vineyards, and quiet Tuscan villages before arriving in Florence — one of Italy's most iconic and beautiful cities.

With a lighter riding day, there's time to explore the city, enjoy incredible food, wander historic streets, or simply relax with a drink watching the world go by.



FLORENCE TO MONTEPULCIANO (VIA AREZZO)

DAY 8

Start Location: Florence

End Location: Montepulciano

Distance: 80 Miles

Highlights:

- Ride through classic Tuscan countryside
- Stop in historic Arezzo — a hidden Renaissance gem
- Olive groves, hilltop towns, and vineyard views
- Arrive in Montepulciano for a golden-hour wine welcome

Leaving Florence behind, today's ride heads deeper into the Tuscan countryside. Quiet roads twist through vineyards, olive groves, and hilltop villages, with stunning scenery around almost every corner.

You may stop for long lunches and coffee in sleepy village squares, or simply continue flowing through the endless curves and rolling hills ahead.

By evening, you arrive in Montepulciano — a stunning medieval town full of stone streets, incredible food, and classic Tuscan atmosphere.



MONTEPULCIANO TO LUCCA

DAY 9

Start Location: Montepulciano

End Location: Lucca

Distance: Approx: 120 Miles

Highlights:

- Cross from southern to northern Tuscany
- Rolling hills, rural roads, and scenic switchbacks
- Arrive into Lucca — the walled city of music and charm
- Evening strolls, piazza dinners, and Tuscan twilight

Today's route cuts across the heart of Tuscany, blending flowing countryside roads with dramatic scenery and timeless villages. The riding here feels effortless — the kind of roads where hours disappear without noticing.

As the day unfolds, you gradually make your way west towards Lucca, one of Tuscany's hidden gems. Surrounded by ancient walls and packed with character, it's the perfect place to spend the evening soaking up the slower pace of Italian life.

By evening, you arrive in Lucca — a walled medieval town full of music, cobblestone streets, and world-class cuisine. The day ends with piazza dinners and the magic of Tuscan twilight.

Today is yours to enjoy however you like.

You may choose to relax and explore Lucca's beautiful old town, wander the historic walls, enjoy long Italian lunches, or simply slow the pace down for a day. Others may head out for a shorter local ride into the surrounding Tuscan hills or down towards the coast.

It's a chance to recharge, soak up the atmosphere, and enjoy a slower side of Italy before the journey turns back towards the mountains.

LUCCA TO THE PIEDMONT FOOTHILLS

DAY 11

Leaving Tuscany behind, the roads begin to climb once again as the route heads north towards the Alps. Rolling hills slowly give way to bigger scenery, cooler air, and sweeping roads that carry you towards the mountains ahead.

The ride flows through northern Italy's quieter countryside — vineyards, open valleys, and small villages passing by as the peaks gradually begin to dominate the horizon once more.

By evening, you arrive in the Piedmont foothills, surrounded by beautiful alpine scenery and the anticipation of tomorrow's mountain riding.

End Location: Piedmont Foothills

Distance: Approx: **145 Miles**

Highlights:

- Leave Tuscany behind as we head north
- Ride through Ligurian countryside & into Piedmont
- Rustic lunch stops & scenic transitions
- Sleep in wine country with mountain views on the horizon



PIEDMONT FOOTHILLS TO COURMAYEUR

DAY 12

Start Location: Piedmont Foothills

End Location: Courmayeur

Distance: Approx. **140 Miles**

Highlights:

- Ride into the heart of the Western Alps
- Climb through Aosta Valley's dramatic scenery
- Optional alpine detours and panoramic passes
- Arrive in Courmayeur under the shadow of Mont Blanc

Today's route heads properly back into the Alps as the roads climb higher into dramatic mountain scenery once again. Expect sweeping passes, towering peaks, deep valleys, and some truly unforgettable riding throughout the day.

This is the kind of riding that makes European motorcycle touring so addictive — endless corners, crisp alpine air, and scenery that constantly pulls your eyes towards the horizon.

By late afternoon, you arrive in Courmayeur beneath the shadow of Mont Blanc, surrounded by some of the most spectacular mountain scenery anywhere in Europe.

End Location: Courmayeur

Distance: Approx. **140 Miles**

DAY 13

Start Location: Courmayeur

End Location: Dijon

Distance: Approx: **180 Miles**

Highlights:

- Cross into France via alpine tunnels or mountain passes
- Ride from high-altitude drama to rolling countryside
- Enter the Burgundy region of France
- Dijon's historic streets, wine bars & relaxed charm

Leaving the high Alps behind, today's route gradually descends into the quieter roads and rolling countryside of eastern France. The dramatic peaks slowly fade into vineyards, flowing sweepers, and peaceful rural landscapes.

It's a brilliant day to simply settle into the rhythm of the road and enjoy the changing scenery as the journey begins its final sweep northwards.

By evening, you roll into Dijon — a beautiful historic city known for its relaxed atmosphere, fantastic food, and rich wine culture.



DIJON TO REIMS

DAY 14

Start Location: Dijon

End Location: Reims

Distance: Approx. 180 miles

- Ride through Burgundy and into Champagne
- Vineyard-lined backroads and peaceful French countryside
- Explore Reims Cathedral & historic centre
- Final night toast with real Champagne

Today's ride continues north through the heart of French wine country. Quiet backroads wind through vineyards, sleepy villages, and open countryside, making for a smooth and relaxed day in the saddle.

Stops along the way might include village cafés, bakeries, or scenic vineyard viewpoints as you gradually make your way towards the Champagne region.

By evening, you arrive in Reims — the historic heart of Champagne and the final major stop of the journey.

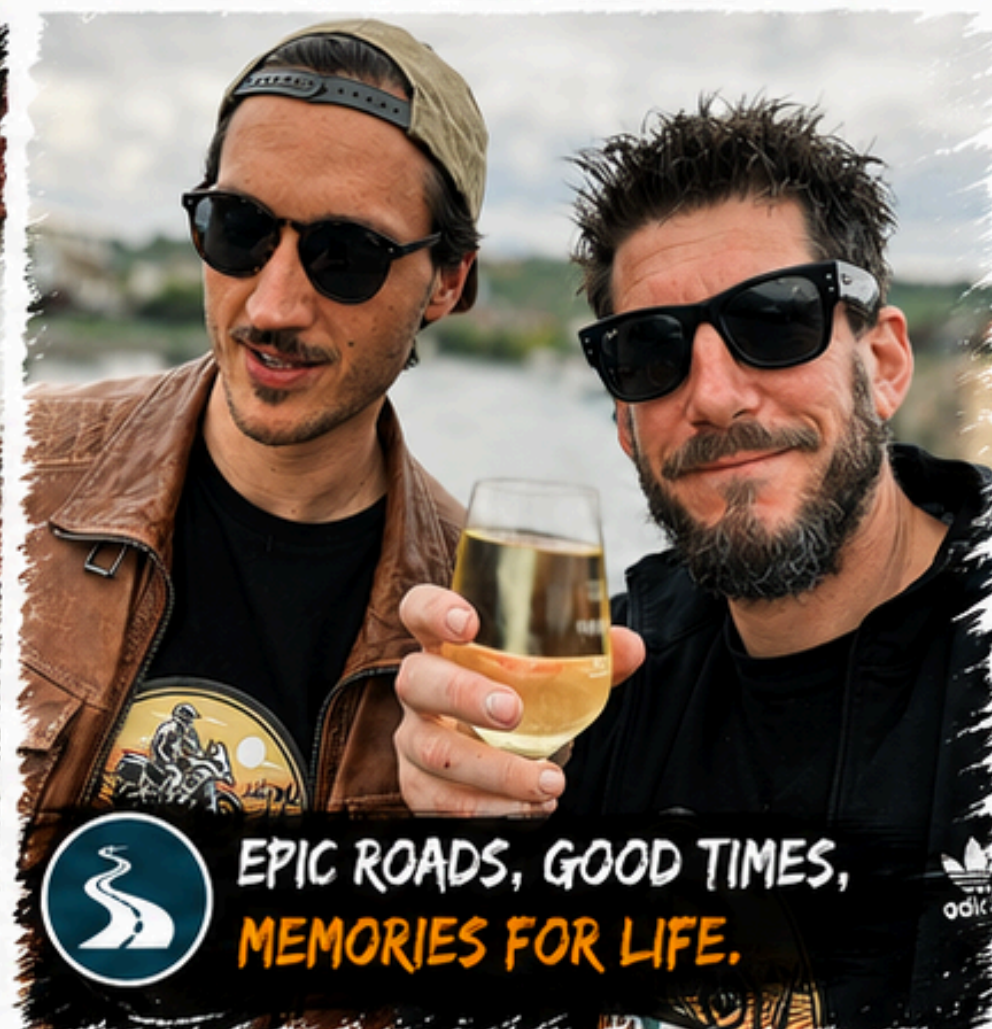

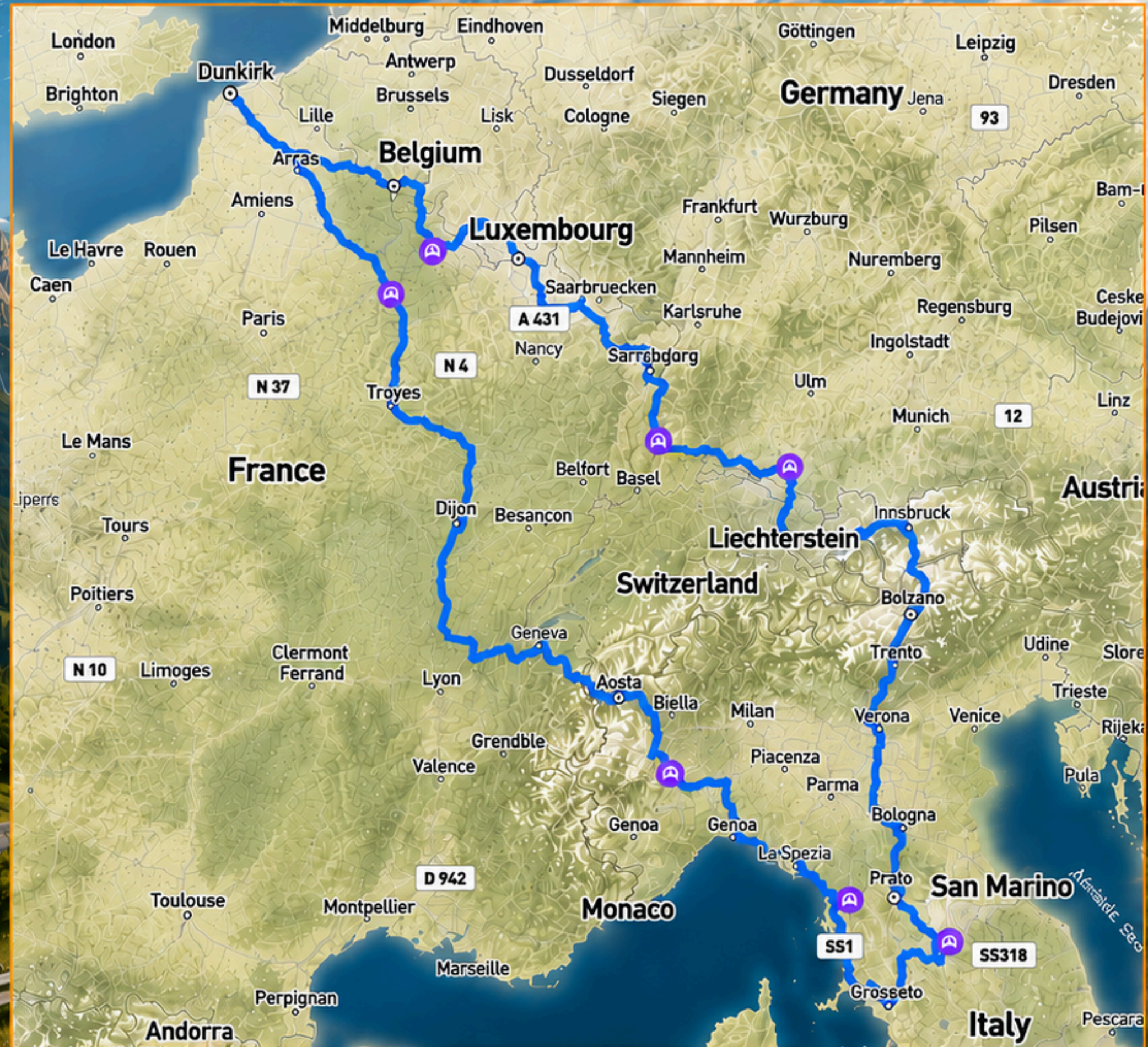
